## “The Tour Itinerary at a glance”

### Day One Tuesday (D)

This morning we will depart for our journey south. We will overnight in southern Virginia. Full Dinner included tonight. Upon arrival at the hotel we will have time for swimming at the indoor pool.

### Day Two Wednesday (B,DC)

Breakfast begins your day as you board the motorcoach for **Music City USA!** Upon your arrival in **Nashville** check into the **Drury Inn & Suites** for the next four nights. *A performance opportunity will be dockside at the General Jackson prior to boarding.* Then board the boat for a dinner cruise featuring an awesome show in the two-story theater and a delicious holiday dinner.

### Day Three Thursday (B,D)

Happy Thanksgiving! After breakfast at the hotel, board your motorcoach for a guided City Tour including the Parthenon. Then we will arrive for a **Country Christmas celebration at the Opryland Resort.** Enter **ICE.** This interactive display of ice sculptures is an awesome way of starting your day. Don't miss the Hall of Trees. This awesome display of decorated trees raises money for charities in Tennessee. Each tree is uniquely decorated to represent a local charity. After lunch on your own take a **Delta River Flatboat Ride** down the scenic indoor river of the Gaylord Opryland Resort. Then you will have free time to explore and shop in one of the twenty-five boutique shops located within the resort. A **Thanksgiving Buffet is included tonight at Ellendale's.** *(possible performance opportunity)*

### Day Four Friday (B,D)

Breakfast starts your day at the hotel. Board your motorcoach for **Memphis ~ Home Rock and Roll.** Visit **Graceland,** home of Elvis Presley. Visiting Graceland takes you on a one of a kind journey through Elvis's humble beginnings and rise to superstardom with up-close and personal looks at the influence that forever changed our music and our lives. Your tour includes admission to the **Mansion, Airplanes, Automobile Museum, Sincerely Elvis and Private Presley Museums.** Your visit would not be complete without an *opportunity for you to perform at the home of the “King of Rock and Roll”.* Before returning to Nashville we are going to visit **St. Jude Children's Hospital.** *A performance opportunity may be available (pending approval).* Dinner is included at Spaghetti Warehouse before returning to Nashville.

### Day Five Saturday (B,D)

Good Morning! Start your day with a stop at historic **RCA Studio B.** Nestled on Music Row this is Nashville's oldest surviving recording studio and most famous studio in the world. Today join Dolly Parton, Willie Nelson, Elvis and many more that have created hits in this famous studio as you **record your own CD in a private recording session.** After lunch on your own we will tour the **Country Music Hall of Fame.** This is the world's largest music museum. *Your visit includes a performance opportunity on the Plaza.* Dinner is included tonight at the **Wildhorse Saloon.** Bring your dancing shoes because after dinner the Saloon is hosting a private Line Dancing lesson for our group. The day isn't over and your visit to Nashville would not be complete without a seat at the **Grand Ole Opry.** During November the show is held at the historic **Ryman Auditorium** (original home to the Opry). Enjoy this live radio broadcasted show featuring some of Country Music's biggest stars.

### Day Six Sunday (B,D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before returning to the **Ryman Auditorium** for a *chance to perform on this historic stage.* Then smile for a group photo as many of today's stars have done. Then we leave Tennessee behind as we travel north to our overnight accommodations in Virginia. Dinner is included.

### Day Seven Monday (B,D)

We will be stopping for an included meal. Later today arrive home with many fond holiday memories of this Tennessee performance tour.
